

The Journey Younger Kids

Jesus often talked about journeys and we each go through many in our life. We can choose to walk these journeys with God and with each other and it can start at any age.

If you've been to the morning community, you'll know we all love the videos we play in church and they show how Jesus lived, how he loves and how we could be like him. For the younger children, seeing what Jesus did and asking them what they think about it can be a great place to start.

Here's how it works:

- 1. Roll your journey dice and find that number in the table on the back of this postcard
- **2.** Read the example of Jesus's actions and ask the child the question for that action
- **3.** If they're unsure, help them get started, maybe you have an example of your own



- **1.** Jesus says we should love each other, like he loves us. Can you do something today that shows you love someone?
- **2.** Jesus calmed a storm to help his friends when they were scared. Could you ask Jesus to help you when you feel scared?
- **3.** Jesus performed miracles, what do you think is amazing in the world?
- **4.** Do you have any favourite songs from church you'd like to listen to or sing? (Search for "Hub Church Songs" on Spotify to find our playlist)
- **5.** Jesus was interested in everyone he met and knew what they could do well. What are you good at? Could you tell others what they are good at?
- **6.** Jesus talked to people that didn't have many friends. Are there people you know that you could be a good friend to and play with?
